Level 3

Day Case Floor

- For Haematology and Oncology patients.
- This area will provide treatment for patients such as blood transfusions and magnesium infusions so they can continue with their chemotherapy treatment.
- It will have a dedicated space which will bring the Brachytherapy and Papillon departments together.
- This area includes treatment chairs and single side rooms for segregation of patients.
- The Clinical Intervention Unit is a nurse led area which will specialise in the placement of central intravenous lines such as PICC lines and Portocaths.
- Apheresis - service provided by NHS Blood & Transplant (NHSBT). This is the process of collecting stem cells either from a patient or a donor to be used as part of a bone marrow transplant.
- Clatterbridge Private Clinic includes four chemotherapy treatment chairs and two consult / exam rooms. Radiotherapy and inpatient stays will happen on other floors.
